### VEUVE AMBAL

Blanc de Blancs - Mousseux (FR)

This Sparkling is fresh and easy to drink and doesn't strain your wallet. Dry crisp finish with a baked apple, pear, quince, subtle dried honey and toasty yeast lees aftertaste.

Prosecco D.O.C NV - Veneto (IT)

100% Glera fruit. Extra dry with crisp acidity - yet delicate and complex with fruity notes of peach, green apple and melon.

### RAMEAU D'OR

Petit Amour Rosé - IGP Méditerranée (FR)

From IGP Méditerranée, France this wine is extremely fresh & delish. Definitely hits the spot and is a staff favourite. Name in English - 'My Little Love'!

### MOJO

Shiraz - Barossa Valley (SA)

Coming from the Barossa region this Shiraz ticks all the boxes from what you'd want from a great tasting Shiraz.

### HESKETH

Cabernet Sauvignon - Coonawarra (SA)

A vibrant, fresh style of Cabernet that is drinking well now, but also has the depth of flavour to age gracefully.

### TAI TIRA

Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough (NZ)

Who doesn't love a delicious NZ sauv...? It's balanced and soft with mouth-watering acidity.

### HESKETH

Chardonnay - Adelaide Hills (SA)

Fresh, vibrant and creamy with pear, stone fruit and a hint of spice. This is a cool-climate Chardonnay that's all class!

### RIFF | ALOIS LAGEDER

Pinot Grigio - Venezia (IT)

Imagine your laying on a beach in Italy, sitting back, with not a care in the world! The palate is fresh, lively, precise, medium-strong body with a long, dry finish.

### LAGIOIOSA PICCOLO

Prosecco - Treviso (IT)

A delicious Italian prosecco with a healthy serving size of 200ml. The initial dry, fresh & flavoursome sensation is followed by a fruity and harmonious aftertaste.

### PERRIER-JOUËT

Grand Brut NV - Champagne (FR)

A melting pot of aromas and flavours, it's a wonderfully rounded & generous champagne. It has the substance and the personality to adapt to any situation, from an aperitif to a main course of white meat or fish in a creamy sauce.

### MAISON SAINT AIX

Rosé - Coteaux d'Aix En Provence (FR)

Gratifying palate with crisp freshness and fleshy fruit followed by a spicy finish. A supple, energetic and very thirst-quenching style.

### STORM BAY

Pinot Noir - Coal River Valley (TAS)

Tassie is the one of the best known regions for pinot noir. Being a light and refreshing drop, it will keep you wanting more!

### TWO HANDS

"Gnarly Dudes" Shiraz - Barossa Valley (SA)

This wine screams Alpha Dog!!! Lovely density and weight, blackberry and plum cascade across the palate with notes of roast meats, pipe smoke and cedar playing a supporting role.

### SHAW + SMITH

Sauvignon Blanc - Adelaide Hills (SA)

Not in to a NZ sauv... Shaw + Smith have become known as a benchmark for Adelaide Hills, and Australian, Sauvignon Blanc.

### CREVARO

5 Tales Chardonnay - Margaret River (WA)

A step up from the Hesketh, this wine finishes smoothly with balanced acidity and lingering ripe fruit flavour with a light touch of French oak.

### LEEWIN ESTATE

Riesling - Margaret River (WA)

This crisp, fresh and dry Riesling has one of the nicest looking labels on offer, while the wine inside does not disappoint!

### FIORE PICCOLO

Moscato - Mudgee (NSW)

Exceptionally sweet with a nice flavour and balance all in a 200ml piccolo bottle. Hell yeah!
